Interchange of Trailer Authority

Any trailer or semi-trailer:


- (a) owned by and licensed under British Columbia Motor Vehicle Act in the name of licensee; or
- (b) licensed by plates or permit under British Columbia Motor Vehicle Act and leased by licensee for exclusive use in the course of licensee's regular transport business; or
- (c) licensed by plates or permit under British Columbia Motor Vehicle Act and leased from another carrier, whether loaded or otherwise, for the express purpose of transporting freight in the course of licensee's regular transport business and/or for freight furtherance under a joint arrangement between lessor and lessee, in accordance with "Conditions of Licence" as specified herein

may be substituted for trailer or semi-trailer described on the licence; provided that:

- (i) where a trailer or semi-trailer has been leased as herein permitted, a written lease agreement must be negotiated, including terms stipulating compensation payable, and a copy of this agreement must be carried on the leased vehicle or towing vehicle and produced upon request of a police officer or constable or officer of the Commission;
- (ii) where a substitute trailer or semi-trailer is used in place of vehicle described on this licence, the gross weight may, subject to limits otherwise established under the laws of the Province, exceed the maximum gross weight as shown on the licence.
